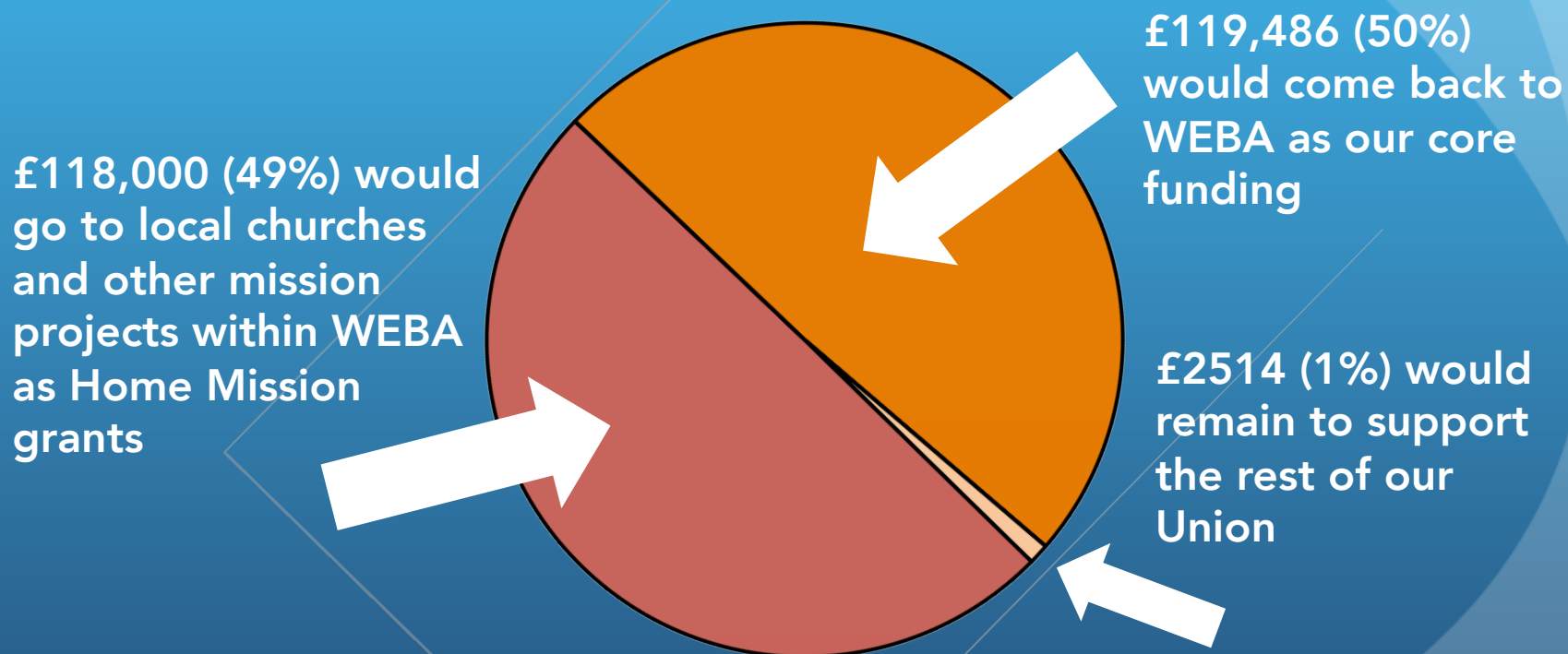


Home Mission Update

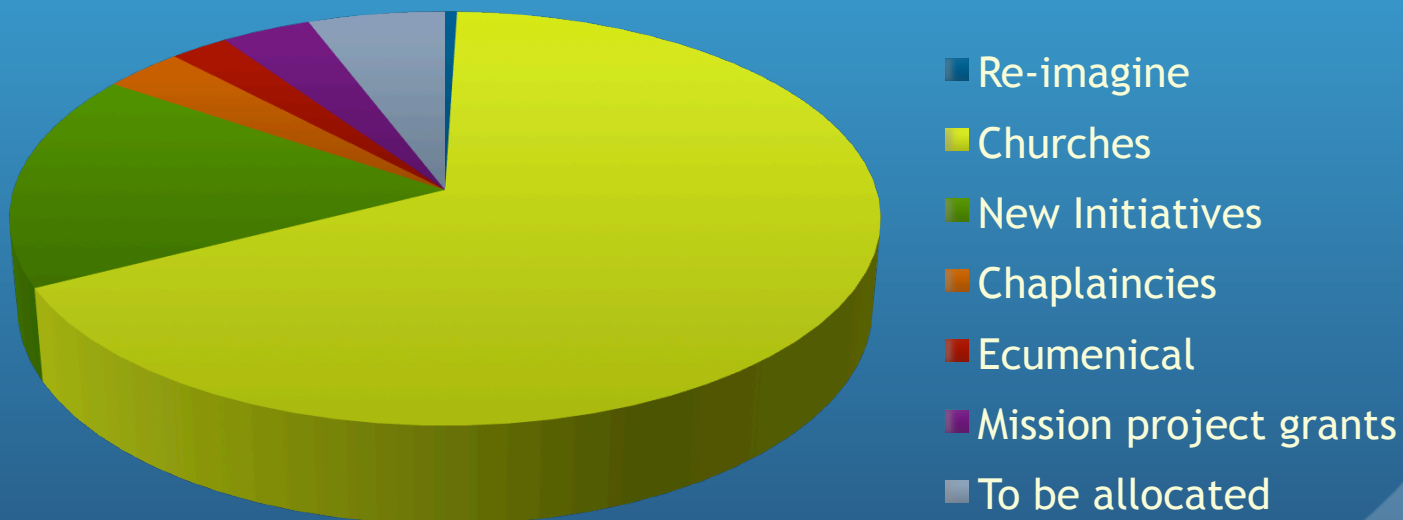
